

SLEEA Cadet Basic Supply List

PLEASE FURNISH EACH EXPLORER WITH A COPY OF THIS LIST

Each Cadet and their parents/guardians will need to take the time to read the information below and become familiar with its contents.

Due to the military style discipline, in-coming telephone calls are not permitted. However, outgoing calls are permitted during free time. Free time is also based on weather or current training. Some days may not have free time.

It gets very hot in South Mississippi during the summer months. We suggest a lot of fluid intake preferably water not soda, etc. during the week prior to arrival.

The items listed are needed for the week:

- Proper personal hygiene items (toothbrush, tooth paste, deodorant, soap, shampoo, etc.)
- ❖ At least two (2) towels and two (2) washcloths.
- Blue or Black shorts, blue or Black t-shirts or departmental t-shirts for running and physical training (a minimum of 3 sets, 4 if possible) there will be time to wash Starting on Monday
- White socks for physical training
- NO white t-shirts are allowed
- ❖ Good running shoes or comfortable walking shoes. Tennis shoes are recommended. 2 pair
- Shorts or pants of **proper fit** for class time. No short shorts or oversized pants that fall down. The Shorts and pants must have belt loops
- Shirts or t-shirts in good taste for class time. (No muscle shirts, tank tops, or inappropriate logos, example: beer, sex, and profanity). A good rule of thumb is to follow your local school district dress code.
- Females need to bring boxer shorts with t-shirts that can be worn in their barracks for nightclothes.
- There will possibly be a water event and clothes suitable for that will be needed. Males will need dark shirts and shorts and females will need to have a dark shirt, dark shorts and a one piece bathing suit for the water event. Also closed toe water shoes will be needed by males and females. PLEASE DO NOT FORGET THESE ITEMS!!
- One pair of navy blue, black or khaki pants with belt loops to be worn at competition.
- Post uniform for graduation and duty belt with belt keepers. (If worn by your agency).
- ***** We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- If you bring a significant amount of money, please have your Advisor hold it and give it to you as needed.
- If you belong to an Agency that does not provide dress uniforms, we suggest a nice set of dress clothes for graduation.
- ❖ Each Cadet may wish to consider purchasing, bringing and wearing a cheap model watch
- Pillow/Blanket and a sheet that fits a full size bed.
- You will need these for outside SUN BLOCK 50 Proof or higher and (Example "OFF Deep Woods") BUG SPRAY!!!

These items are not allowed:

- ❖ Pepper mace, knives, weapons of any sort, fireworks, water guns or balloons, etc.
- * No tobacco products /alcoholic beverages or Vapes (If caught you will be dismissed and may face criminal prosecution).
- No junk food (candy, chips, etc.)
- ❖ No gum
- Large amounts of make-up (you will not have time)
- Jewelry or cologne (male or female)
- No electronic devices Note: the cadet can have a cell phone but it must be turned into their advisor before they check in at the Academy
